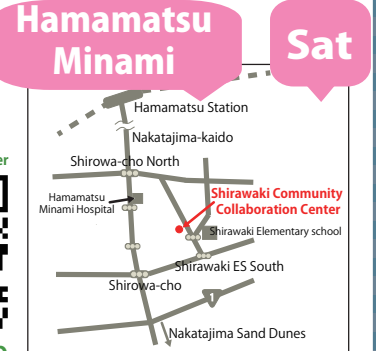

Runs from August 24th (Saturday) – November 9th (Saturday) Total of 12 Classes – Every Saturday

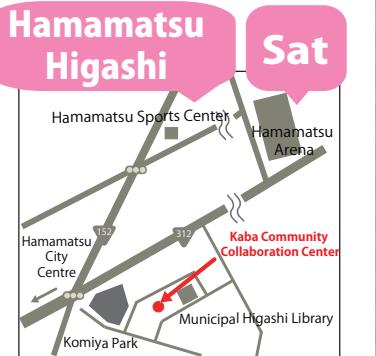

Location : Hamakita Regional Activity and Training Center (2829-1 Oro, Hamana-ku, Hamamatsu-shi)

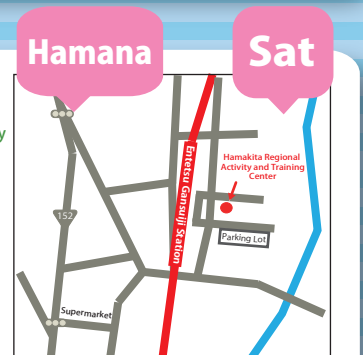
